4. Secretary's Report

This season has been dominated by the Pandemic and subsequent lock down. Up until March things were ticking along nicely then on 17th March the league took the decision to cancel all remaining fixtures, a few weeks later the decision was taken to finalise the league tables based on the average points scored up to and including the 16th March.

The committee held two face to face meetings this season and two Zoom calls. Clearly the zoom calls have focused on the impact of the lockdown and how we can get back to playing badminton.

With the lock down, along with all other clubs and activities, we were forced to cancel all remaining club nights. We are finally looking to restart club nights on Tuesday 8th September. These will be carefully controlled and in line with UK Government advise so attendance will be limited to 24 people for each 2-hour session – we are providing three sessions per week so there should be plenty of court time for all club members to have at least one slot. In order to attend you must register in advance using the app and details previously published.

Fortunately, we continue to have a strong and growing membership. This season we had 65 players registered, up 4 on the previous year.

The club entered the Playford Trophy again this year, and have reached the Semi Final against Glevering once again. As a result of the lockdown the semi-final and final are still to be played. The league is hopeful that the remaining matches can be played once competitive matches can resume.

At the league AGM on Tuesday 1st September it was agreed that the normal league would be suspended for the 2020/21. This is brought about by a combination of reasons, lack of halls, lack of players and the current BE guidelines of only have six people on a court in a "bubble". The league committee will be proposing an alternative league structure/competitive play format for the latter half of the 2020/21 season – details yet to be decided.

The promotions and relegations resulting from the 19/20 season will carry over to this time next year and be used at the start of the 21/22 season.

5. Treasurer's Report

- a. Prior to the meeting Adam circulated copies of the club accounts, these are copied below. Other points to note:
 - i. The accounts finish at the end of April 2020, so activity tailed of from end of March when matches where stopped.
 - ii. Club finished with a profit at end of season of £181.
 - iii. Assetts around £5000 made up of £3500 in the bank, £1000 pending gift Aid payment and a number of shuttles.
 - iv. Lack of Summer Club will impact on next years accounts as the profit (around £500) helps the main club finances.
 - v. The accounts are still to be audited.
 - vi. Subject to audit completing the Accounts were proposed by Brendan Goffin, Seconded by Sue McKinley and agreed by all.

7. Playing arrangements for 2020/21

8. Fee Structure for 2020/21

The meeting agreed that there would be a straight forward $\pounds 5$ per session on a pay and play basis. The £35 the committee originally discussed will not be charged to current members of the club ie those that were members in the 2019/20 season.

Sessions will be bookable one week in advance, if there is space then we may offer spaces to other clubs – the mechanics of this will need to be worked out.

The fee structure will be reviewed after one month to ensure the club remains on a sound financial footing.

- **a.** First Aid Kits. In light of the Covid situation it was agreed the committee should review the contents of the first aid kit and ensure suitable PPE is available to anyone dispensing first aid.
