Secretary's Report - 20 May 2010

This is my first report as Secretary and follows on what I believe has been a very successful season for the club, both in terms of the development of the club and the league positions achieved by our teams.

I would like to report the following: -

- Committee Meetings The Committee met on three occasions during the year, two were held prior to the start of the season to organise the "Beginners Improvers" section and a further meeting was held in February concerning the arrangements for Summer Club. My thanks go to all the committee members who have devoted time and effort to make the season run so well. A particular thanks to Adam who has established a "First Class" Website for the club, which has given us a greater opportunity to keep members up to date with what is going on in the club. This will also act as a permanent advert for the club, and many new members have made their first contact with the club through the website.
- 2. No of playing member We registered 41 players with Badminton England this year, of which three were juniors. In addition two further members are registered through other clubs. This is by far the most we have registered in recent years. In all we have had 74 players attend at least one club night.
- 3. League Positions This year has seen the best results for the Mens teams for at least 15 years. The tables below show each team and how they finished in their respective leagues.
