## Secretary's Report - 25 May 2017

This is my seventh and last Secretary's report. I have served on the Committee for eighteen years. I would like to report the following: -

- We fielded 12 teams in the Ipswich and District League, the most teams fielded by a single club. Unfortunately after setting the matches for Ladies C we had to withdraw the team. This had impacts on our finances along with some of our other teams playing in reduced match divisions.
- 2. No of playing members We registered 48 players with Badminton England this year, 6 less than we registered last year.
